In 2007, these kits were distributed within hours of the tornadoes hitting Piedras Negras and Eagle Pass in April. The completed kits will be

distributed again as needs arise. Having kits packed and ready for delivery means affected families will receive needed goods immedi-

ately when a disaster strikes.

Bring supplies (see the list) and deliver them to the designated spot at the Municipal Auditorium, then join others as we put our mission and ministry into action. Kits will be distributed through the diocesan disaster relief effort and the World Mission Department.
